

Transcription of the John Frizzle Albritton Family Bible

Facsimile copies of the family data recorded in the Family Bible attributed as belonging to John Frizzle Albritton were published in the family histories written by the late Eleanor Davis McSwain [1] and the late Bobby G. Albritton [2]. Transcriptions are also available on various websites [3]. The Bible was last owned by Mrs. Fran Lomas, but its current whereabouts are unknown.

The transcription presented here was made by T. D. Hudson in 2019 from original pages of the John Frizzle Albritton Family Bible. The copies available to us today include the Bible's title page and the four pages of family information. The original order of the pages is unclear, and I have arbitrarily numbered them A, B, C, and D. At the very top of all four pages was this printed item: "*FAMILY RECORD*," and I have omitted this in the transcription below. Each of the four pages was divided into two columns.

All items in italics font are verbatim transcriptions from the original pages from the Bible, with the precise punctuation and spellings in the original record. To clearly indicate each individual entry, I have bulleted them in this transcription, but the bullets are my addition for ease of reading and were not part of the original Bible record.

John Frizzle Albritton was the son of [Enoch Albritton](#) and Penelope Frizzle, and he was the namesake of his maternal grandfather, [John Frizzle](#) (c1717–1818). Enoch and Penny married about 1793 in Pitt County, North Carolina, where both of their families had lived for decades. About 1807, they moved to Georgia and lived in Laurens and Wilkinson Counties. About 1818, John F. Albritton married Mary, daughter of Abel Polk and Eunice Parramore.

By the mid-1820s, the extended Albritton family had settled a short distance off the Federal Road on the west side of Cedar Creek, at the location that soon became the village of Snow Hill, in Wilcox County, Alabama. John and Mary Albritton lived there until the latter 1830s, when they moved to nearby Conecuh County, Alabama. John died in 1843, either in Conecuh or Wilcox Counties, and about 1849, the widowed Mary moved her family to Pontotoc County, Mississippi. She died there in 1865.

Transcriber's Note: The entries on this page are more difficult to decipher than on other pages, especially those recorded on column 2.

- *Jesse R. Albritton Son of John F. Albritton and Mary his wife Departed this life Sept. 28th AD 1844*
- *Marth D. Albritton daughter of John F. Albritton and May [sic] his wife Departed this life August 1st AD 1847*
- *Maryann P. Albritton the daughter of Silas W. A. Albritton and Eunicy his wife Died Aug 28th AD 1837*
- *Susanah Albritton the daughter of S. W. A. Albritton and Eunicy his wife Died May 16th AD 1839*
